

Dear families,

We know that it is just the start of the summer holidays, and we certainly don't want to wish the time away, but during this time you may need to purchase new uniform or school shoes for your child. We thought this information would be a timely reminder of the school expectations as we wouldn't want you to buy anything unnecessarily or purchase the wrong items and need to replace in September.

School Bags Children do not need large bags into school. Our cloakrooms are tight on space. Large bags often fall off the pegs creating a tripping hazard.

Children only need to carry their reading book, reading record, homework book, water bottle and possibly a lunch box and waterproof jacket to school. Please consider this when choosing a bag with your child. Often a drawn-string bag will be big enough.

In Reception and KS1, all children will need a book bag. These are kept in the classrooms so that they are easily accessible. It is highly likely that children in Reception and KS1 will have no need for any other bag.

Uniform Logoed uniform is available from Monkhouse or for free from our Swap Shop. Children do not need to wear logoed uniform, but they must wear a red polo shirt and navy-blue jumper or cardigan. These can be purchased from any number of shops.

We ask that children wear black or charcoal grey tailored shorts, tailored trousers or skirts. Leggings, sports or cycling shorts should be reserved for PE days. In the warmer months, children can wear a red gingham summer dress. We ask that tights and long socks are grey, black or red.



Footwear Shoes must be completely black. Trainers are permitted providing they too are completely black.











PE Kit Children should wear a white T-shirt or poloshirt with black or navy, non-branded shorts, joggers or leggings. Children may wear any suitable sports shoe on a PE day. In order to keep warm, children should either wear their uniform jumper, fleece or cardigan or they may wear a red hooded jumper.













Children must not bring any toys or fidgets. Pencil cases are permitted at the teacher's discretion.
